6:35 Meeting called to order (Adam)

President's Report: Request for at least two people to shadow our Treasurers as they are both parents of seniors and we want to be ready for next year. Jani F. will handle the CA trip.

Form letter for tax credit on-line now to fundraise for CA trip.

Seatbacks – 11/21 will be next game to sell at – sign up through Theresa Riel

Schwan's frozen food – Patty Oldstead (UHS teacher) will give us 25 % of food sales but we will have to deliver – to be discussed

11/18 Choraliars/Jazz Band Concert Silent Auction – if you bring an item to auction and it sells – money goes directly to student's IMF

Far Horizons Complex (Tom Wurr) may be a stop after Vet's Day Parade – lots of retirees; we perform and they potentially donate tax credit to the group. Tom would pursue – motion/ 2nd/approval for him to pursue.

Spirit Sales – making about \$500/week. T-shirts are in.

Jason Hess – webmaster – THANK YOU from group for all he is doing.

Pre-practice meals: Restaurant meals will be served; pizza once/week. Need a parent (or multiple) volunteer. Adam B. and Caitlin (student) will do this service temporarily until someone steps up.

Publically thanked Tom Wurr for his excellent service and commitment to the band program for years.
